

Repellent Tips!

Keep safe from **mosquitoes** and West Nile virus...



How to choose:

Pick repellents with one of these active ingredients:

- ✓ DEET
- ✓ Picaridin
- ✓ IR3535
- ✓ Oil of lemon eucalyptus
- ✓ Para-menthane-diol


When applying:

- ✓ Apply to exposed skin only.
- ✓ First spray on hands and then apply to face, avoiding eyes and mouth.
- ✓ Do not apply on cuts or irritated skin.
- ✓ Follow label instructions; reapply as directed.



After returning indoors:

- ✓ Bathe or shower.
- ✓ Wash treated clothing.



Repellent Safety:

- ✓ Adults should apply on children - keep repellents out of children's reach.
- ✓ DEET should be used only on infants aged 2 months and older; plant-based repellent oils should be used only on children aged 3 years and older.
- ✓ If a rash or other reaction develops, wash off repellent and call your doctor.
